Method

Step 1: Locate the most recent predefined target species list for the fishery from the fishery management website for each jurisdiction or other available source. Determine the stocks with which the fishery interacts.

Step 2: Obtain stock status classifications for each target species stock relevant to the fishery from the SAFS website (fish.gov.au) for the most recent year. Species may have multiple stock entries (based on stock location) - collect the SAFS classification for each relevant fish stock for each target species of the fishery. If stock status is unavailable for any of the target species in the past 5 years, report "Data not found" for those species and the year of data collection for the framework.

Step 3: Report the stock status for each relevant target species fish stock and the data's year of provenance. If year of provenance is not available, record the year of data collection for the framework.
