## Method

Step 1: Determine the jurisdiction (State/Territory/Commonwealth) in which the fishery operates.

Step 2: Search for policies or statutes in the fishery's jurisdiction active within the past 5 years describing the allocation of fish stocks between fishing sectors. The sectors to consider are commercial, recreational, and/or Indigenous, Customary, Aboriginal, or Traditional Owners.

Step 3: If any policies or statutes are found from the past 5 years, report "Present". Otherwise, report "Data not found". Report the year of data collection for the framework.

## Data Sources

Data sources are determined by the search script.
